About the Position

EATS Park City is seeking a part-time Compost Coordinator in Park City, Utah. The EATS Compost Coordinator will be responsible for overseeing composting programs at Park City School District elementary schools during the 2021-2022 school year.

The Compost Coordinator will be responsible for helping students sort their lunch waste from **10:30am-12:30pm Monday through Friday**. This could look like physically being on site attending lunchtime, coordinating volunteers for lunchtime, or both.

Responsibilities

- Attend lunchtime at Parley's Park, Jeremy Ranch, or McPolin Elementary School to help students and teachers sort food waste.
- Educate students and teachers about composting and inspire them to create less food waste.
- Advocate for school composting programs at other elementary schools.
- Coordinate volunteers to attend lunchtime and help with composting.
- Clean compost bins, position compost bins as required by Momentum Recycling staff for pickup.

Qualifications

- Experience or interest working with youth in formal and/or informal education programs required.
- Interest in waste diversion and sustainability.
- Minimum 16 years of age.
- Commitment to and passion for EATS Park City's mission.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds.

Terms and Benefits

Part-time employment for 15 hours a week, \$12/hour. Non-benefited position.
